Las Vegas - On Tuesday, August 17, 2010, Attorney General Catherine Cortez Masto and Ward 6 Las Vegas Councilman Steven D. Ross, in support of the Nevada Foreclosure Prevention Taskforce, will hold a news conference to release details of the Month of Prevention Campaign to Stop Foreclosure Fraud.
